#### Clyde Potts Reservoir and Dam

#### Spillway Infrastructure Improvement Project, General Maintenance, and Security Information

November 7, 2016

The Southeast Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority (SMCMUA) is writing to residents who live near the Clyde Potts Reservoir and Dam to inform of active work projects as well as procedures regarding security related to the facility and its surrounding area.

As part of the 2016 Capital Improvement Program, SMCMUA will implement rehabilitation of the Clyde Potts Reservoir Dam (Dam) concrete spillway. This project is scheduled to begin in November 2016 and is planned to be completed by the end of October 2017; however, the actual final completion date may be extended since the project is weather dependent.

The work to be completed includes concrete repairs along the spillway of the Dam. SMCMUA has contracted with Civil Dynamics, Inc. to oversee these repairs. The repairs will be made by Ferraro Construction Corp. Project work hours will be between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. It is unlikely that any work will take place during inclement weather events. Ferraro Construction will stage their equipment in the vicinity of the Dam along Woodland Road and/or in the parking lot by the Clyde Potts Water Treatment Plant at the intersection of Woodland Rd and Cold Hill Road.

As part of the 2016-2017 general maintenance of the properties, SMCMUA has contracted with Custom Care Services for general groundskeeping in and around the reservoir and dam. This work will also be conducted between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Clyde Potts Reservoir Dam and its surrounding area is private property owned and operated by SMCMUA. In the interest of the health, safety, and general welfare of our customers and neighbors, anyone found on property without direct permission from SMCMUA will be prosecuted for trespassing.
