C. Resolution Authorizing Use of Vendors Under Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council

The Board reviewed a memorandum from the Chief Financial Officer dated January 10, 2023, requesting authorization to purchase certain items from authorized vendors under the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (MCCPC) during the 2023 Budget year. The purchases of goods and services by local contracting units through the County agency without advertising is authorized under Section 12 of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11–12. The vendors listed in the memorandum have been awarded MCCPC contracts. D. Resolution Authorizing Purchase of Digital Scale Controllers

The Board reviewed a memorandum from the Water Quality dated December 5, 2022. SMCMUA previously requested proposals for the purchase of Scaletron digital scale controllers as part of its corrosion control treatment upgrades. Scaletron Industries Ltd. Provided correspondence stating that Environmental Service & Equipment Co. Inc. ("ESEC") is the sole source distributor for this equipment sold in New Jersey. ESEC submitted a proposal for the providing of such equipment at a maximum amount of \$34,920.00. The purchase would be made without public bidding as being less than the bidding threshold of \$44,000.00 provided in the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seg.). ESEC completed and submitted Business Entity Disclosure Certifications which certify that they have not made any reportable contributions to any political or candidate committee in the Township of Hanover, Borough of Morris Plains, Town of Morristown and the Township of Morris in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit them from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract.
